As the first African-American woman to lead an NBA team, Marshall guided the Mavs to become the standard for inclusion and diversity in the NBA. Prior to joining the Mavs, Marshall served as Senior Vice President – Human Resources & Chief Diversity Officer at AT&T. Her work landed AT&T in the Top 3 on Diversity Inc's Top 50 list of companies, and for the first time, placed AT&T on Fortune's 100 Best Companies to Work For, one of only two Fortune 50 companies. Marshall was named one of Adweek's 30 Most Powerful Women in Sports and selected as one of the 2019 Women of Power Legacy Award honorees by Black Enterprise, among many other awards throughout her career. She is the author of You've Been Chosen, a memoir detailing how she has beaten the odds in both her personal and professional life, overcoming domestic violence, racial barriers, a cancer diagnosis, and more.

JAMIE KERN LIMA

Founder IT Cosmetics; New York Times Best-Selling Author

Jamie Kern Lima is a *New York Times* best-selling author and founder of IT Cosmetics, which she started in her living room and grew the company into the largest luxury makeup brand in the country. She sold the company to L'Oréal in a billion-dollar deal and became the first female CEO of a brand in its 100+ year history. Her love for her customers and remarkable authenticity and belief eventually landed her on the *Forbes* America's Richest Self-Made Women list. She's a mother of two and an active investor, speaker, and thought leader who is passionate about inspiring and elevating women. She's also an active philanthropist who has funded leadership training in more than 200 prisons and shelters across the United States and has donated over \$40 million in product and funds to help women face the effects of cancer with confidence. Her second book, *WORTHY: How to Believe You Are*, is scheduled to release in February 2024.

DALLAS JENKINS

Creator, Director, and Co-Writer of The Chosen

At the age of 25, Dallas Jenkins produced the independent feature *Hometown Legend*, which was distributed by Warner Brothers. In the 20 years since, he has directed and produced over a dozen feature and short films for Universal, Lionsgate, Pureflix, Hallmark Channel, and Amazon. He is now writing, directing, and producing the largest crowd funded media project of all-time, a multi-season series about the life of Jesus entitled *The Chosen.* A global phenomenon, The Chosen is the largest fan supported entertainment project of all time and has garnered over 500-million-episode views worldwide. It's available on major streaming services like Amazon Prime, Netflix, and Peacock while all seasons remain free in *The Chosen: The Messengers* debuted at No. 1 in the U.S. box office in 2021.

ANITA ELBERSE

Anita Elberse is the Lincoln Filene Professor of Business Administration at Harvard Business School. An award-winning teacher and scholar, Professor Elberse develops and teaches an MBA course covering the "Businesses of Entertainment, Media, and Sports," which ranks among the most sought-after courses in the School's curriculum, and chairs a short executive education program, also named "The Business of Entertainment, Media, and Sports." In her research, Professor Elberse primarily aims to understand what drives the success of products in the entertainment, media, sports, and other creative industries, and how firms can effectively manage products and talent in such sectors. She is acclaimed for her work on digital-media strategies. Professor Elberse has conducted case studies on dozens of entertainment companies and personalities, including The Walt Disney Studios, Live Nation, NBCUniversal, the NFL, Nike, and Spotify. Several of these are described in her first book, *Blockbusters: Hit-making, Risk-taking, and the Big Business of Entertainment*. Professor Elberse is one of the youngest female professors to have been promoted to full professor with tenure in Harvard Business School's history.
